DISCOVERY AND RECOVERY GROUP FACILITATORS: Facilitators for these groups must be mature laypersons who are far enough along in their own recovery and spiritual journey to facilitate a supportive group for others with similar struggles.

THE MOURNING AFTER MINISTRY: Members needed to write and address sympathy cards to members who have experienced the loss of a family member.

RECOVERY FOR LIFE GROUP FACILITATOR: Facilitators for these recovery groups must have a successful personal recovery experience, 12-step group experience, and experience in the group served.

STEPHEN MINISTRY: Mature, trained laypersons are needed to extend God's grace to other strugglers through a listening ear and a caring heart.

YOUTH MENTORS: Mentors are needed who are willing to walk alongside youth ages 11-17. Meetings include life skills lessons, activities, sports, and community service. A group of men mentor a group of boys and a group of women mentor a group of girls each Thursday night from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. for 10 weeks each fall and spring.

KIDSHARE—DIVORCE RECOVERY FOR CHILDREN

Four adults are needed to help the Kidshare group leader in working with kids ages 8-11 who are dealing with divorce. This is a ten-week group that meets on Thursday nights for 1½ hours. Serving as a helper to the leader is also part of the training to become a Kidshare group leader.

MAKING WISE CHOICES

For children ages 8-10. This group will use Christian based curriculum to guide children in making wise choices. Adults needed to help with the 10 week group twice a year.
